VILLAGE TRAIL/QUIZ

This is a walking trail. All clues to be found within easy walking distance of the Community Centre and can be viewed from the road or footpaths. Please respect peoples property and do not enter gardens or property unless invited,

Start at the Community Centre.

Leave the Community Centre by the pedestrian gate on to Horncastle Road and cross the road.

- Beyond the neatly pollarded willow tree, in the year1989.. (1) a Royal visitation from HRH...THE PRINCESS ROYAL/PRINCESS ANN.....(2) heralded the opening of this ...WOODMANS.....Court (3)

Turn around and take a left turn past the older Council bungalows .
Turn left to take the footpath across Ormsby House Drive Estate

- ...BINEBECA..... (4) a place of whitewashed houses and narrow streets
- No beer made hereBATEMAN'S COTTAGE..... (5)
- Spot a lake that's not a lake.....DERWENT...(6
- Head for where the rising sun shines on a menagerie at Number...7.....(7) What animals can you see.....BADGER PIGS HARE OR RABBIT.....(8)

Emerge from the path

- No children here today.....SCHOOL..... (9)

Turn right to head towards the main road

- ...LAVINIA..... (10) A woman of Rome
- Available in the spice aisle of most grocery stores.....BAY.....(11)
- Could Barnaby be investigating this addressMIDSUMMER HOUSE..... 12)

At the end of the lane take a moment to look around

- Giving refuge from the sea with lights to guide poor souls like me.....HARBOUR LIGHTS.....(13)
- In the distance a reminder of bygone activities of cutting and grinding THE MILL/WINDMILL(14)

Head East

- What time is the Saturday collection.....7am.....(15)
- What type of the tree you are standing near...HORSE CHESTNUT.....(16)
- You are now viewing the site of the former Gosling's Garage, Do you know In what month and year the last Goslings Bus Service left from Mareham-le-Fen.....MARCH.....(17).....1960.....(18)
- No vehicles can enterLAMMINS LANE.....(19) from here.
- Could this be where Derek and Rodney visited their uncleALBERT HOUSE.....(20))
- To commemorate the Queen's Diamond Jubilee this tree was planted by CLLR L T W HODGSON.....(21) on behalf of.....PARISHIONERS OF MAREHAM LE FEN.....(22)
- Another tree was planted near here to commemorate the village winning The Best kept large village competition. In what year ...1969.....(23)
- The Eagles are flying high here, but who are they...CRYSTAL PALACE FOOTBALL CLUB.....(24)

At the junction of Fieldside and Revesby corner turn left.

- Stand for a moment at the entrance to DIIDESFLE ESNCETR (anagram).....FIELDSIDE CRESCENT.....(25)
Often seen as a harbinger of death or doom this chappy looks happy enough in this garden...ROOK/CROW/RAVEN.....(26)
- Once a common roadside sight in Dairy farming areas.....MILK CHURN STANDS.....(27)

- Bilbo was drawn to this by its luminescent beauty
.....**ARKENSTONE**.....(28)
- Did the Goddess of Agriculture lodge here**CERES
LODGE**..... (29)

Walk ahead into Fieldside East

- It may be a Goose, it may be a River or it may be the office of David
...**THE BRENT**.....(30)
- No early morning calls from this fine fellow
...**COCKEREL**.....(31)
- Beware the catchpit outside ...**MILLFIELD
HOUSE**.....(32)
- A vital part of construction.....**PADSTONES**.....(33)
- How many Finches are eating the berries...**6**.....(34)
- A great range of performance
bikes.....**CARRERA**.....(35)
- A Civil Parish of the Scottish
Borders.....**TRAQUAIR**.....(36)
- A place of Law and Order in days gone by ...**THE OLD POLICE
HOUSE**.....(37)

Cross the junction and continue along Fieldside West

- Built in the year 2000 but who does it honour.....**ALL THOSE WHO
HAVE SERVED THE PARISH... IN THE LAST
CENTURY**.....(38)
- Find 3 traditionally built.....**MUD AND
STUD**.....(39) cottages that the village
is noted for**TWYNHAM
COTTAGE**.....(40)**POTTER'S
HERON**.....(41).....
ORCHARD COTTAGE.....(42)
-**PRINGLES**.....(43) premiered in Evansville
Indiana in 1968, Initially a flop this tasty snack bears a logo of a
man with a moustache . Now three homes where there was
once a field for horses.....**THE PINGLE**.....(44)
- Note the sign for the breeding colony of gregarious birds.....**THE
ROOKERY**.....(45)

Head South down Watery Lane

- These animals are not friendly**BADGERS
BYTE**.....(46)

- Can the apes solve the problem at the farmhouse.**MONKEY PUZZLE TREE**.....(47)
- How many hedgehogs can you spy through the window ...**2**.. (48)
- What colour umbrella is White Rabbit carrying.....**BLUE**.....(49)
- They have usually taken flight by September
.....**SWALLOWS**.....(50)
- Could this be a Gloucester Old Spot at.....**NURSERY**..... Farm Cottage (51)
- You may come here to witness these little gems emerging from the cold winter ground ...**SNOWDROP LODGE**.....(52)
- A reminder of the tree in which the future king of England Charles II hid.....**ROYAL OAK**.....(53) BUT who was he hiding from
...**ROUNDHEADS/PARLIAMENTARIANS/CROMWELL**.....
..... (54)

TURN LEFT INTO MAIN STREET

- “Bus stop, wet day, she’s there, I say..... “ a hit for this 60’s band...**THE HOLLIES**.....(55))
- Thinking of taking up a new hobby. You would be welcome here.....**BOWLS CLUB**.....(56)
- Look out for a place to buy all your household needs**DUNELM COTTAGE**.....(57)
- Did Doctor Foster visit this place in wet weather...**GLOUCESTER HOUSE**..... (58)
- You might get these if you feed the chickens without your shoes and socks on.....**PECKS**.....(59)
- A Beef breed of this area – good for your Sunday roast.....**LINCOLN RED**.....(60)
- No wood cutters working here
...**FORRESTERS**.....(61)
- How many miles is it from Spilsby to Sleaford
.....**28 miles**.....(62)

Turn left into Horncastle Road

- None of (60) sheltering here ...**THE OLD BYRE**.....(63)

Continue ahead towards the Church turning left along the Church footpath

- Can you spot something across the Green to your left that could be a lifesaver to someone in need.....**DEFIBRILATOR**.....(64)

- These trees are commonly found in Churchyards.....**YEW**.....(65)

BEAR RIGHT AT THE END OF THE PATH IN THE DIRECTION OF CHURCH ROAD

- It thrives in shade, grows quickly to cover nearby walls and is of value to wildlife ...**IVY**..... (67)
- ARTA (anagram...)...**TARA**.....(68)
- Your car will be crushed if you park here unless it's a**VOLVO**.....(69)
- Cute but sly and topping the weathervane.....**FOX**.....(70)
